

Marketplace IGA , RE/MAX Sea to Sky Real Estate and Kokanee Crankworx presents the 4th Annual Ken Quon Memorial “Ride On” and RE/MAX Corridor Cup Team Challenge - Sunday August 9th 2009

The Ken Quon Memorial “Ride On” Team Challenge, Family Ride and Après Barbeque Fund raiser will be held on Sunday August 9th 2009, - 11:00 am (sign-in from 9:30 am) at the Riverside RV Resort and Campground for the Start/Finish/BBQ. The event will take place over the roads and trails in the vicinity of Lost Lake with an entry donation and is designed to be for all ages and abilities.

This fund raiser provides an opportunity for the Whistler cycling community and others who were connected to, or touched by Ken, a chance to contribute back to Whistler and Pemberton’s emergency services. A fund has been created in Ken’s name that will help purchase items that will assist the emergency services (Ambulance, Fire Dept. and Clinic) in addressing the emergency needs of Whistler and Pemberton area residents and visitors. Over the course of the previous 3 events, the fund has equipped 3 of Whistler’s ambulance vehicles and 1 of Pemberton’s with Welch Allyn Propaq® Encore patient monitors. This is a portable system that can be easily brought to a patient and stay with them to provide state-of-the-art monitoring all the way to medical care. These have proved invaluable in the Whistler environment. This year it’s our goal to similarly equip Pemberton’s ambulance service.

This year’s Ken Quon “Ride On” will be comprised of three cycling events - all taking place at the same time.

1. The traditional family tour starting at the Riverside Campground will meander on the wide Lost Lake trails to ‘Proposal Corner’, walk up to Ken’s memorial, place a flower and ride back. This is a family friendly cycle route, as there will be no ‘Riders’ or ‘Racers’ on these trails.*

*The Family Ride will feature a special draw prize for all participating children under 12 yrs. old consisting of 2 bikes - one for a boy and one for a girl. - Sponsored by Whistler Dental - Dr. James McKenzie.

Cost: Adults \$10.00 Children - \$5.00*

2. The Ken Quon “Ride On” ride is the traditional WORCA ‘Loonie’ type ride on a combination of crush, plush and single track trails. Riders will place a flower on Ken’s memorial as they pass near the memorial on the ride. Riders will complete one lap of the course.

Cost: Adults - \$15.00 Juniors \$10.00*

3. “The RE/MAX Corridor Cup Challenge”. A two member team event designed to crown the best mountain bike team of the Sea to Sky corridor. The lowest total team time will win the RE/MAX Corridor Cup Challenge and the Cup will reside in the RE/MAX office in the winning team’s community. The team race will be three laps of the Ken Quon course.
